#### Public Hearing

- SB 747  
Establishes student loan insurance as class of insurance in Oregon.
- SJR 18 \*\*      \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Rules  
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require Legislative Assembly at regular session held in odd-numbered year to pass bill appropriating funds for state's system of kindergarten through grade 12 public education before passing any bill appropriating funds for any other state agency.
- SJR 20 \*\*      \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Rules  
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require Legislative Assembly to pass bill appropriating funds for state's system of kindergarten through grade 12 public education by 65th day of regular session held in odd-numbered year and to prohibit compensation of legislators if bill is not passed.
- SB 803 \*\*      \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Education to award grants to school districts for support service programs, education innovation programs and education intervention programs.
- SB 136  
Moves up sunset date for authority of school districts to establish post-graduate scholar programs to June 30, 2019.

#### Work Session

- SB 274  
Requires each post-secondary educational institution that provides housing for students to provide to each student enrolling or registering at institution for first time information on vaccine-preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age.
