Public Hearing

- SB 136
Moves up sunset date for authority of school districts to establish post-graduate scholar programs to June 30, 2019.
- SB 395 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to, on annual basis, work with Oregon Health and Science University, each public university and each community college to determine number and graduation rates of former foster children and current foster children at each college or university.
- SB 396 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish foster youth success centers in each public university.
- SB 551 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to develop and implement pilot program to assist foster youth transitioning from community college to public university.
- SB 706
Directs Department of Education to administer pilot program to provide professional development and instructional resources to component school districts through education service districts.
- SB 278 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Education to conduct study related to school social workers.

Work Session

- SB 440 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Education to prepare list related to high-wage and high-demand jobs in state, distribute list to school districts and award grants to school districts to ensure list is distributed to students in grades 9 through 12.
- SB 905 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Rules
Abolishes Oregon State Police Dignitary Protection Unit.
SB 905 is scheduled for the sole purpose of returning it to the Senate President for referral to another committee.
