- SB 196  
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to ensure that any policy adopted by public institution of higher education for determining whether part-time faculty members are eligible for health care benefits use aggregate total of hours worked by faculty member at all public institutions of higher education.
- SB 206  
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to develop policy to permit faculty at community colleges to receive compensation from private or public resources.
- SB 111 \*\*  
Establishes grant program to assist school districts in complying with school nursing service requirements. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 142 \*\*  
Requires school district to screen certain students for symptoms of Irlen syndrome and to ensure specified staff members receive training related to Irlen syndrome. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

#### Work Session

- SB 351  
Directs Secretary of State to conduct audit of use of statewide summative assessment in public schools in this state.
