Public Hearing

- SB 758 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Establishes refundable credit against personal income taxes for contributions to higher education savings network account.
- SB 759
Specifies that amount in account established for higher education expenses is disregarded for purposes of determining account owner's financial eligibility to receive assistance or benefit authorized by law, to extent permitted under federal law.
- SB 1002
Directs district school boards, public libraries and tribal libraries to adopt policies related to use of school facilities and library facilities by private tutors.
- SB 996 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs State Registrar of Center for Health Statistics to send to Department of Consumer and Business Services each calendar quarter names of children born in Oregon to residents of this state.

Work Session

- SB 182 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Educator Advancement Council.
- SB 1003
Prescribes requirements for screening tests related to dyslexia.
- SB 1032 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Amends Oregon Promise program to remove prohibition on awarding more than \$10 million in grants per fiscal year.
