#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 911 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Establishes Indian Health Scholarship Program to provide free tuition and fees for qualifying Indian health profession students in exchange for student commitment to work at tribal service site after graduation.
- SB 576  
Requires that at least 25 percent of Oregon Opportunity Grant moneys be awarded to students committed to majoring in science, technology, engineering or mathematics fields.
- SB 443  
Requires that at least 25 percent of Oregon Opportunity Grant moneys be awarded to students committed to majoring in science, technology, engineering or mathematics fields.
- SB 889 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Education to conduct study on funding for instruction of talented and gifted children.
- SB 887  
Directs school districts to identify certain students to receive information about opportunities related to advanced placement examinations.
- SB 353 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means  
Establishes Task Force on the High School Graduation and College and Career Readiness Act.

#### Work Session

- SB 253  
Requires institutions of higher education to provide fact sheet to each applicable student detailing amount of education loans received, estimate of total amount of education loans student will owe at graduation, estimate of amount student will have to pay each month to service loans and percentage of borrowing limit student has reached for each type of federal loan.
