### **Public Hearing**

HB 2311

Makes 40-40-20 higher education goals relate to Oregonians completing education, rather than to all adult Oregonians.

HB 2666 A

Gives community college recognized student government authority to establish process and allocate mandatory student-initiated fees, subject to refusal under certain circumstances by board of education of community college district or president of community college.

HB 2956 A

Directs Early Learning Council to conduct evaluation of Early Learning Hubs and submit report on evaluation each odd-numbered year.

HB 3340 A

Requires Department of Education to develop and provide to public high schools written materials regarding apprenticeship opportunities.

HB 2864 A

Requires each community college and public university to establish process for recommending, and providing oversight for implementation of, cultural competency standards for institution and institution's employees.

### **Work Session**

HB 2219 A

Encourages school districts and public charter schools to offer students courses or other educational opportunities in civics.

HB 2258

Expands types of entities that may receive funding for certain activities related to science, technology, engineering and mathematics education and to career and technical education.

HB 3313

Allows public charter school to give priority in admission to students who had resided within service boundaries of nonchartered public school that closed within two years prior to public charter school beginning to operate.

Updates certain terms and references used throughout state law to conform with changes to federal law associated with enactment of federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.
