SB 634

Adds woody biomass to list of types of energy generating technology that are green energy technology that must be included in constructing, reconstructing or renovating public buildings, and for which contracting agency must set aside 1.5 percent of contract price.

SB 836

Redefines "de minimis level" for purposes of Toxic-Free Kids Act.

SB 847

Creates process for State Land Board, Department of State Lands and Legislative Assembly to coordinate transfer of certain trust lands managed for benefit of Common School Fund that have limited performance potential as assets of Common School Fund to certain other public bodies better positioned to manage lands for benefit of public.
