Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 1007
Directs State Department of Energy to develop climate test to conduct reviews for approval of proposed fossil fuel infrastructure projects.
- SB 1037
Allows local government to inhibit or prevent production or use of seed or seed products for purpose of protecting seed or products that are not genetically engineered from adverse impacts of genetically engineered seed or products or if enforcing local measure approved by county voters on May 20, 2014.
- SB 1048
Permits city or county to adjust property line through progression of property line adjustments that incorporates further adjustments of adjusted properties.

Work Session

- SB 197 **
Requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule program for regulating air contaminant emissions from dairy confined animal feeding operations. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 418
Requires Director of Department of Land Conservation and Development, at city's request, to approve or remand sequential phases of work tasks related to potential amendment of urban growth boundary.
- SB 557 **
Repeals greenhouse gas emissions goals and requires Environmental Quality Commission to adopt by rule statewide greenhouse gas emissions goal for 2025, and limits for years 2035 and 2050. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 865
Requires county or city governing body to submit subdivision or partition plats to certain special districts for district approval prior to approval by governing body.
- SB 892
Requires filing notice with State Forestry Department of proposed aerial application of pesticide as planned forest management activity on privately owned forestland.
