Public Hearing

HB 2256 A

Makes dietary supplements, as defined, food for purposes of Oregon Food Law and laws regulating sanitation for food and food establishments.

HB 2364

Corrects inaccurate statutory reference.

HB 3116 A

Allows producer to sell candled eggs designated as ungraded under limited circumstances.

HB 2533 A

Eliminates State Department of Agriculture bee colony registration fee for colonies having primary purpose of producing new queens or workers to start new colony or add to existing colony.

Work Session

HB 3176 A

Authorizes court, when imposing sentence, to consider whether defendant committed crime while under duress, compulsion, direction or pressure from person who has committed certain acts against defendant.

Note change: the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources and the House Committee on Energy and Environment will not be meeting jointly. The informational meeting has been removed. House Bills 2256, 2364, 3116, 2533, and 3176 have been added. The committee will meet in HR C.
