#### Public Hearing

- HB 2515  
Provides that historic cemeteries be accessible to persons conducting historical research.
- HB 2516  
Allows State Parks and Recreation Department to issue permits to entities to restore, maintain and preserve abandoned cemeteries.
- HB 2030 A  
Removes certain restriction on number of nonresident annual black bear tags that may be issued by State Fish and Wildlife Commission for general hunting season.
- HB 3158 A  
Requires State Fish and Wildlife Commission to implement program to encourage reporting of wildlife law violations.

#### Work Session

- HB 2143 A  
Designates first Saturday in June of each year as Oregon Outdoor Recreation Day.
- HB 2179 A  
Permits onsite treatment of reclaimed water, agricultural or industrial process water or biosolids prior to application on exclusive farm use land using treatment facilities that are portable, temporary and transportable by truck trailer.
- HB 2405  
Authorizes State Parks and Recreation Director to adopt rules to establish standards used when department disburses moneys to tribal governments under state or federal programs and to make state funding assistance available to tribal governments for constructing and restoring memorials honoring veterans and war memorials on public property.
- HCR 8  
Celebrates 50th anniversary of Oregon's Beach Bill.
