Public Hearing

SB 157

Requires deposit of percentage of corporate minimum tax revenue to Oregon Rainy Day Fund.

Work Session

SB 28

Requires all members of affiliated group of corporations to be treated as single taxpayer and requires sales of all members to be included in numerator for computation of Oregon apportionment percentage if any member is taxable in state.

SB 123

Authorizes formation of children's special districts.

SB 564 **

Establishes prudent maximum amount of outstanding General Fund-supported debt as amount for which debt service due in biennium equals five percent of General Fund revenues estimated to be received in biennium.
