HB 2779 A

Sets conditions under which person or agent collecting moneys for state agency may take more than one business day to transmit moneys to State Treasurer.

HB 2964

Extends ad valorem property tax exemption to existing qualified dwelling units of single-unit housing purchased by taxpayers seeking exemption.

HB 2150

Carried Over from the 5/22 Agenda: Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to allow manufacturers or importing distributors of wine, cider or malt beverages to file required statements and pay privilege taxes by electron means.
