Work Session

- SB 12
Authorizes Oregon Business Development Department to require fingerprints of certain persons for purpose of requesting state or nationwide criminal records check.
- SB 86
Authorizes Oregon Department of Administrative Services to require fingerprints of certain persons who are employed by or applying for employment with qualified entity or who provide services or seek to provide services to qualified entity.
- SB 87 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Legislative Information Management and Technology then to Ways and Means
Permits State Chief Information Officer to decide whether state contracting agency or public corporation must obtain quality management services for information technology initiative in specific circumstances.
- SB 90 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Legislative Information Management and Technology then to Ways and Means
Transfers information technology security functions of certain state agencies in executive branch to State Chief Information Officer.
