Public Hearing SB 588 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Secretary of State to appoint inspectors general to review spending of certain entities and identify inappropriate costs.

SB 605

Requires agency to include comparative analysis of costs and benefits of rule in notice of proposed rulemaking.

SB 628

Requires state agency to report to Governor and Governor to include in budget report total cost of compliance to public and small businesses of agency's rules.

SB 629

Requires state agencies to carry out delegated duties in least costly manner.
