#### **Public Hearing**

SB 861

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/14/2017 AGENDA: Removes, for health care facilities that receive preponderance of revenue from associated comprehensive group-practice prepayment health care service plans, exemption from financial data reporting required by Oregon Health Authority for other facilities.

### **Work Session**

SB 743

Creates violation prohibiting business that makes retail sales of product containing dextromethorphan, or employee of business, from selling or delivering product to individual 17 years of age or younger unless individual has valid prescription.

#### **Public Hearing**

SB 785

Makes legislative findings regarding routine provision of antibiotics to food-producing animals and its relation to public health.

SB 744

Directs Oregon Health Authority to adopt rules providing for dissemination of information by health care practitioners to patients concerning bone marrow donations.

SB 859

Requires physician to discuss issues related to fertility with adolescent oncology patient.

SB 964

Allows physician assistants to use hospital facilities for patient care.
