Work Session

SB 270

Prohibits issuing initial prescription for opiates to adults for outpatient use in quantity exceeding seven-day supply.

SB 272

Defines "prescription drug formulary" for purposes of Insurance Code.

SB 419 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Creates Hospital Rate Commission in Oregon Health Authority to review hospital charges billed by certain hospitals

and recommend to Oregon Health Authority whether to approve charges as reasonable based on prescribed criteria.

Makes legislative findings regarding routine provision of antibiotics to food-producing animals and its relation to public health.

Public Hearing and Work Session

Requires Oregon Health Authority to conduct study of effectiveness of Oregon Integrated and Coordinated Health Care Delivery System in improving health outcomes for medical assistance recipients.

Work Session

SB 914

Establishes that decisions related to immunizations are personal health care decisions and that immunizations may not be mandated as condition of employment unless required by federal law.

SB 934

Prohibits coordinated care organization from spending less than 14.4 percent of global budget on primary care and community health.

SB 997

Establishes penalty to be imposed by Department of Consumer and Business Services on employers that offer health insurance coverage to employees but that have employees working at least 20 hours per week who receive health care coverage through medical assistance program.
