SB 243

Expands definition of "child in care" to include children receiving care and services from certified foster homes and developmental disabilities residential facilities.

SB 244

Establishes notification requirements of Department of Human Services regarding reported or suspected deficiency violations or failures of child-caring agency to comply with full compliance requirements and regarding reports of suspected child abuse of child in care.

SB 245

Modifies definitions of "child" and "child-caring agency."

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

SB 636 **

Defines finding of unsubstantiated report of abuse of child in care.
