Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

SB 243

Expands definition of "child in care" to include children receiving care and services from certified foster homes and developmental disabilities residential facilities.

SB 244

Establishes notification requirements of Department of Human Services regarding reported or suspected deficiencie violations or failures of child-caring agency to comply with full compliance requirements and regarding reports of suspected child abuse of child in care.

SB 245

Modifies definitions of "child" and "child-caring agency." Declares emergency, effective on passage.

SB 246

Sets forth circumstances under which Department of Human Services may immediately suspend, revoke or place conditions on license, certification or other authorization of child-caring agency.

SB 636 **

Defines finding of unsubstantiated report of abuse of child in care.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Authorizes child abuse investigation or interview of child who is subject of child abuse report on private as well as public school premises.

SB 103 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Requires court to make specific findings of fact following receipt of certain reports in juvenile proceedings. 105

Requires independent residence facilities for minors to be licensed, certified or authorized by Department of Humar Services under laws regulating child-caring agencies.

SB 506 **

******Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Exempts public or private official from reporting child or elder abuse when official acquires information that official reasonably believes has already been reported and is already known by law enforcement agency or Department of Human Services.
