#### SB 243

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2/6/2017 AGENDA: Expands definition of "child in care" to include children receiving care and services from certified foster homes and developmental disabilities residential facilities.

## **Public Hearing**

Removes requirement that superintendents of certain state institutions administered by Oregon Health Authority and Department of Corrections designate chief medical officer of institution.

SB 48

Directs Oregon Health Authority and certain professional regulatory boards to adopt rules requiring professionals to complete continuing education related to suicide risk assessment, treatment and management. 239 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary then to Ways and Means

SB 239<sup>\*\*</sup>

Establishes process to determine consent of resident of residential care facility or adult foster home to individually based limitation of certain rights. 397 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

SB 397 \*\*

Directs Department of Human Services to convene work group to develop common client confidentiality release form to be used by public bodies and community organizations to enable and facilitate appropriate sharing of confidential information.
