SB 101 ** *Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Authorizes child abuse investigation or interview of child who is subject of child abuse report on private as well as public school premises.

The following bills are scheduled solely for the purpose of moving them to the Senate Committee on Education

SB 395 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to, on annual basis, work with Oregon Health and Science
University, each public university and each community college to determine number and graduation rates of former
foster children and current foster children at each college or university.

SB 396 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to establish foster youth success centers in each public university.

SB 434 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means Creates Task Force on Wildfire Damage Financial Relief.

SB 594 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits

Restores availability of tax credit for employment-related child care expenses and extends credit sunset. SB 310

Authorizes city or county to designate area within jurisdiction as vertical housing development zone.

Establishes timelines by which evaluations must be completed to determine eligibility for special education.

SB 652 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Establishes automatic restraining order against petitioner in Family Abuse Prevention Act proceeding that restrains petitioner from directly or indirectly causing respondent to violate certain terms of Family Abuse Prevention Act order.
