- SB 53  
Modifies licensing fees paid to Oregon Health Authority by in-home care agencies and hospice providers.
- SB 104  
Modifies provisions relating to registry of persons who provide care in certain facilities.
- SB 231 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means  
Establishes Task Force on Student Mental Health Support.
- SB 275  
Permits covered entity to deny request for copy of health information regarding individual who is appealing denial of Social Security disability benefits if requested by person other than individual or individual's personal representative without valid written authorization signed by individual.
- SB 760  
Removes requirement, for abuse reporting purposes, that contact between public or private official and abused person or abuser be while acting in official capacity.

#### Public Hearing

- SB 363 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Education to conduct study on methods for improving safety of work environments for staff involved in special education and related services.
- SB 711  
Establishes public policy that Department of Human Services employee whose employment is terminated for violating duty to report abuse is not eligible for reinstatement of employment with department.

*Note change: SB 231 and SB 760 have been added to this agenda, while SB 246 has been removed.*

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
