Public Hearing

- SB 51 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means
Establishes Task Force on Behavior Health.
- SB 860
Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to conduct certain investigations into parity of reimbursement paid by insurers to mental health providers and physicians.
- SB 833
Requires hospital that discharges patient following attempted suicide to facilitate referral of patient to peer support program.

Work Session

- SB 239 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary then to Ways and Means
Establishes process to determine consent of resident of residential care facility or adult foster home to individually based limitation of certain rights.
- SB 830
Changes definition of foster parent who is "current caretaker."
