- SB 140 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Youth Authority for gang intervention services in Multnomah County.
- SB 141 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Education for Youth Development Division for gang prevention services in city of Gresham.
- SB 314 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Early Learning Division to establish Relief Nursery programs statewide that are certified by Oregon Association of Relief Nurseries and provide trauma-informed services to at-risk children statewide.
- SB 223
Requires in-home caregivers employed by or contracting with in-home care agencies to meet training requirements for home care workers established by Home Care Commission.
