#### Work Session

SB 246

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/20/2017 AGENDA: Sets forth circumstances under which Department of Human Services may immediately suspend, revoke or place conditions on license, certification or other authorization of child-caring agency.

#### Public Hearing

SB 140 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Youth Authority for gang intervention services in Multnomah County.

SB 314 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Early Learning Division to establish Relief Nursery programs statewide that are certified by Oregon Association of Relief Nurseries and provide trauma-informed services to at-risk children statewide.

SB 223

Requires in-home caregivers employed by or contracting with in-home care agencies to meet training requirements for home care workers established by Home Care Commission.

#### Work Session

SB 58

Modifies duties and authority of Long Term Care Ombudsman.

SB 59 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Authorizes Long Term Care Ombudsman to petition for protective order regarding person in long term care facility or residential facility when ombudsman believes person who is subject of petition is in need of protective services.

SB 95 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Requires certain securities professionals to report suspected financial exploitation of elderly, disabled or vulnerable individual to Department of Consumer and Business Services and Department of Human Services.

SB 833

Requires hospital that discharges patient following attempted suicide to facilitate referral of patient to peer support program.

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**AGENDA (Cont.)**  
**March 22, 2017**

- SB 834  
Requires Department of Human Services to develop and present proposal for creation of human rights commission to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services and health no later than September 1, 2017.
- SB 860  
Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to conduct certain investigations into parity of reimbursement paid by insurers to mental health providers and physicians.
