Work Session

- SB 949
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/3/2017 AGENDA: Makes noncompetition agreement with home care worker voidable by home care worker.
- SB 833
Requires hospital that discharges patient following attempted suicide to facilitate referral of patient to peer support program.
- SB 314 **
Directs Early Learning Division to establish Relief Nursery programs statewide that are certified by Oregon Association of Relief Nurseries and provide trauma-informed services to at-risk children statewide. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 263
Limits school district's ability to require students to participate in abbreviated school day program.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 948
Prohibits employment by publicly funded residential facility of individual found to have committed type of abuse that is disqualifying under rules adopted by Department of Human Services.

Public Hearing

- SB 841
Clarifies that state agencies and departments shall purchase certain products and services from Commission for the Blind.
- SB 687 **
Provides that definition of "abuse" does not include refusal to vaccinate child or decision to delay vaccination of child. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Health Care
