SB 263

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Limits school district's ability to require students to participate in abbreviated school day program.

SB 819

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Expands parameters of duties and responsibilities of Critical Incident Response Team assigned by Department of Human Services upon becoming aware of fatality of child that was result of abuse or neglect.

SB 268 **

******Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Requires Department of Human Services and law enforcement agencies to investigate reports of abuse that occurred at school or in educational setting or that are made by school employees. SB 1023 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Establishes Deaf, Deaf-Blind and Hard of Hearing Fund. SB 58

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Modifies duties and authority of Long Term Care Ombudsman.

SB 48

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Directs Oregon Health Authority and certain professional regulatory boards to adopt rules requiring professionals to complete continuing education related to suicide risk assessment, treatment and management.

SB 749

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Requires Department of Human Services to, upon request, reassign caseworker to child, ward, youth or youth offender who is 12 years of age or older and in legal custody of department.

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AGENDA (Cont.) April 17, 2017

SB 944

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/12/2017 AGENDA: Requires Department of Human Services to study and report to Legislative Assembly on effectiveness of specified program approaches in providing access to mental health and addiction services for seniors and persons with disabilities, and to make recommendations for expanding access to services.

- SB 1024
- Requires county to allow siting of accessory dwelling unit in area zoned rural residential.

SB 241 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Children of Incarcerated Parents.

SB 833

Requires hospital that discharges patient following attempted suicide to facilitate referral of patient to peer support program.
