SB 11 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Modifies annual salaries of judges of Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Oregon Tax Court and circuit courts.

SB 34

Expands "move over law" to include any motor vehicle that is displaying warning or hazard lights or specific indications of distress.

SB 76

Defines "unarmed combat sports." Authorizes Oregon State Athletic Commission to regulate unarmed combat sports.

SB 5

Modifies laws related to student athlete agents.

SB 14

Modifies Director of Department of Corrections' review of county's compliance with community corrections intergovernmental agreement to require biennial review instead of annual review.
