SB 249

Establishes procedures for person to file motion to vacate judgment of conviction for prostitution if person was victim of sex trafficking at or around time of offense.

SB 250

Creates affirmative defense to crime of prostitution if, at time of alleged offense, defendant was victim of certain trafficking crimes.

SB 252

Allows person issued hardship permit to drive for purpose of participating in gambling addiction treatment.
