## **Public Hearing and Work Session**

SB 493 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates new manner of committing crime of assault in the fourth degree when person with criminal negligence causes serious physical injury to vulnerable user of public way by means of motor vehicle.

SB 497

Defines "arrest," for purposes of procedures to file motion to set aside record of arrest, to mean action by law enforcement officer or prosecuting attorney that results in official record that person is alleged to have committed offense.

SB 507

Clarifies crimes classification categories that may be expunged if requirements met.

SB 323

Provides that person commits crime of arson in the second degree if person manufactures controlled substance and causes fire or explosion that damages building or damages property in amount exceeding \$750.
