Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 511
Creates debt to state and account receivable for overpayment of support obligation that is transmitted by Department of Justice to obligor, collection agency, child support agency of another state, agency of this state or any other person or entity.
- SB 513
Removes requirement that child support administrator provide 10 days prior notice to obligor or obligee that consumer report for obligor or obligee will be requested by administrator.
- SB 514
Removes requirement to send notices to obligees in certain support proceedings.
- SB 516
Requires that all orders for payment of child support and spousal support have monthly due date of first day of month in which payment is due.
- SB 517
Authorizes administrator to limit, in accordance with rules adopted by Department of Justice, amount of credit for payments of support not made to department.
