Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 356
Renames crime of intimidation as bias crime.
- SB 357
Removes entering or remaining unlawfully in or on public transit vehicle or public transit station as manner of committing crime of interfering with public transportation.
- SB 519
Allows polygraph test as condition of employment for preemployment screening of law enforcement officers, subject to applicable collective bargaining agreement.

- SB 493 **
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/14/2017 AGENDA: Creates new manner of committing crime of assault in the fourth degree when person with criminal negligence causes serious physical injury to vulnerable user of public way by means of motor vehicle. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 751
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/14/2017 AGENDA: Prohibits form of marriage application, license or record from requiring address for person or entity authorized to solemnize marriage.
