SB 494 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/23/2017 AGENDA: Establishes Advance Directive Rules Adoption Committee for purpose of adopting form of advance directive to be used in this state.

SB 768

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03/23/2017 AGENDA: Requires Oregon Health Authority to establish and operate statewide registry for collection and dissemination of advance directives.

Public Hearing

SB 49

Prohibits removal of youth from current placement for purpose of receiving fitness to proceed evaluation.

SB 126

Authorizes juvenile offender subject to mandatory minimum sentence to be eligible for conditional release after serving at least one-half of sentence imposed.

SB 967

Provides that youth offenders sentenced to mandatory minimum terms of imprisonment for certain crimes committed at 15, 16 or 17 years of age are eligible for conditional release hearing if they are in custody of Oregon Youth Authority upon attaining 24 years and six months of age.
