#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 844  
Authorizes Department of Corrections to collect portion of certain moneys in inmate trust account for transitional fund and payment of court-ordered financial obligations.
- SB 846  
Prohibits use of physical restraints in juvenile court proceedings on youth, youth offender or young person with exceptions.

#### Work Session

- SB 360 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs Department of Corrections to establish by rule community service exchange program for person to enter into agreement with community-based organization to perform community service in lieu of payment for delinquent fees or debts and supervision fees.
- SB 493 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Creates new manner of committing crime of assault in the fourth degree when person with criminal negligence causes serious physical injury to vulnerable user of public way by means of motor vehicle.
- SB 692 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Public Defense Services Commission for pre-entry pilot program.
