SB 215

Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish and operate statewide database for collection and dissemination of orders for rare disease emergency response medical treatment for purpose of ensuring safe treatment of individuals with rare diseases in emergency situations. **Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means

SB 898 **

Establishes Task Force on Custody and Parenting Time.

SB 1014

Authorizes law enforcement agency to transfer marijuana items forfeited to agency as result of conviction to nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary.

SB 1031

Prohibits person from engaging in business as debt buyer unless person first obtains certificate of registration from Department of Consumer and Business Services.

Work Session

SB 257

Modifies crime of official misconduct in the first degree to include commission of official misconduct in the second degree when misconduct places another person in danger of physical injury or damages property of another.

SB 323

Provides that person commits crime of arson in the second degree if person manufactures controlled substance and causes fire or explosion that damages building or damages property in amount exceeding \$750.
