SB 59 A

Authorizes Long Term Care Ombudsman to petition for protective order regarding resident in long term care facility, residential facility or adult foster home when ombudsman believes resident who is subject of petition is in need of protective order.

SB 95 A

Requires certain securities professionals to report suspected financial exploitation of vulnerable persons to Department of Consumer and Business Services .

SB 509

Directs Division of Child Support of Department of Justice to adopt certain rules regarding application of payments of child support or spousal support for purpose of achieving consistency with federal laws.

SB 510

Requires insurance companies to enter into agreements with Department of Justice to provide information and financial records to department for claimants who are obligors of past due support.

SB 512

Modifies laws regarding establishment of parentage of child.

SB 682

Provides that obligor's incarceration and release from incarceration are substantial changes of circumstances to modify or suspend orders for support of child.

SB 765

Directs Administrator of Division of Child Support of Department of Justice to conduct statewide study regarding child support no later than July 1, 2018.

SB 1041 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study expenditure of public moneys on alcohol and drug treatment and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2019.
