Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 261
Makes evidence about sexual behavior or predisposition inadmissible in civil proceeding except under certain circumstances.
- SB 525
Extends sunset on provision authorizing Department of Human Services to appear as party in juvenile court proceeding without appearance of Attorney General.
- SB 722
Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study imposition of fees in criminal cases and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before February 1, 2019.
- SB 767
Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study recidivism rates of sex offenders and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before February 1, 2019.
- SB 1042
Authorizes Governor to enter into agreement with another state for purpose of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of marijuana-related businesses.

- SB 2 **
Renames offense of operating motor vehicle while using mobile communication device as offense of operating motor vehicle while using mobile electronic device. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 292
Creates unlawful employment practice and violation of Oregon Safe Employment Act for creating or maintaining abusive work environment.
- SB 356
Renames crime of intimidation as bias crime.

- SB 360 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs Department of Corrections to establish by rule community service exchange program for person to enter into agreement with community-based organization to perform community service in lieu of payment for delinquent fees or debts and supervision fees.
- SB 494 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes Advance Directive Rules Adoption Committee for purpose of adopting form of advance directive to be used in this state.
- SB 693
Eliminates probationary driver permits.
- SB 844
Authorizes Department of Corrections to collect portion of certain moneys in inmate trust account for transitional fund and payment of court-ordered financial obligations.
