Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2307

Provides that certified evaluator who conducts court-ordered evaluation of criminal defendant concerning issue of insanity is not obligated to evaluate defendant's fitness to proceed unless issue of defendant's fitness to proceed arises during evaluation.

HB 2309 A

Provides that progress reports of defendants lacking fitness to proceed who have been committed to state mental hospital or facility for treatment may consist of updates to original examination reports or evaluations.

HB 2619

Permits pawnbroker to notify pledgor by electronic mail or other electronic means that pledge is at risk of forfeiture if pledgor agrees in writing to notification method.

HB 2972 A

Prohibits public university, community college or Oregon-based private university or college to use threat or imposition of student discipline or other sanction to influence decision of victim of alleged incident of sexual assault, domestic violence or stalking regarding whether to report alleged incident or participate in investigation or adjudication of alleged incident.
