Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2357
Extends provisions relating to contempt of court by corporations to other entities that are not natural persons.
- HB 2358 A
Increases charitable gaming maximum prize value for bingo or lotto games.
- HB 2611
Subject to collective bargaining agreement or employment agreement, requires law enforcement unit that hires police or corrections officer originally hired by another law enforcement unit, upon written request of original employing law enforcement unit, to reimburse original employing law enforcement unit for certain expenses incurred by original employing law enforcement unit.
- HB 2618 A
Increases certain fees collected by sheriffs.
- HB 2777
Authorizes mass transit districts to establish administrative process to adjudicate certain ordinance violations.
