#### Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2621 A

Specifies what constitutes notification to law enforcement officials for purpose of determining eligibility of crime victim for Department of Justice compensation award.

HB 3056

Prevents extinguishment of lien upon entry of judgment in action to recover unpaid planned community or condominium assessment.

HB 3057 A

Requires board of directors of association to use certain information when conducting reserve study of reserve account.

HB 3059 A

Precludes right of recovery by transferor of special declarant rights to interest in condominium or planned community.

HB 3176 A

Authorizes court, when imposing sentence, to consider whether defendant committed crime while under duress, compulsion, direction or pressure from person who has committed certain acts against defendant.

HB 2673 A
