#### Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2625 A

Provides that forfeiture petition may be filed for animal impounded pending outcome of animal crime even if specific animal is not named in charging instrument.

HB 2732 A

Provides that person who enters motor vehicle to remove child or domestic animal in imminent danger of suffering harm is not subject to criminal or civil liability if person meets certain requirements.

HB 3177

Allows seizure, constructive possession and forfeiture of hens and chicks used in connection with cockfighting operation.

HB 3283 A

Amends findings by Legislative Assembly regarding provision of care and treatment for impounded or seized animals.
