Public Hearing and Work Session

- HB 2597 A
Renames offense of operating motor vehicle while using mobile communication device as offense of operating motor vehicle while using mobile electronic device.
- HB 2598
Expands offense of vehicular assault to include contact with motorcycle, motorcycle operator or motorcycle passenger.
- HB 2740
Increases age of trafficked person from 15 to 18 for crime of trafficking in persons for use in commercial sex act.
- HB 2807 A
Provides that affidavit submitted to court in support of petition for approval of settlement of personal injury claim of incapacitated person, minor or decedent is confidential.
- HB 3446 A
Provides that court has authority to enter judgment of conviction for Class A misdemeanor at any time after person has successfully completed sentence of probation if person was convicted of criminal driving while suspended or revoked and court makes certain findings.
