HB 3047 A

Creates exception allowing use of unmanned aircraft system capable of firing bullet or projectile in certain circumstances.

HB 3242 A

Requires peace officer to electronically record custodial interview with person under 18 years of age when investigating person felony, or allegation that person under 18 years of age committed act that if committed by adult would constitute person felony.

HB 2616 A

Sets forth circumstances under which court shall appoint counsel for youth in juvenile delinquency proceedings. HB 2618 A

- Increases certain fees collected by sheriffs.
- HB 2622 A

HB 3030 A
