HB 2505 A

Subject to enumerated exceptions, expands definition of "communication in support of or in opposition to a clearly identified candidate or measure" within definition of "independent expenditure" to include aggregate expenses of \$750 or more that refer to candidate or political party within 30 calendar days of primary election or 60 calendar days of general election.

HB 2584 A

Lists specified types of expenditures that are definitively considered to be made in coordination with candidates for purposes of determining whether expenditure is considered independent expenditure.

HB 2873 A
