HB 2873 A

HB 3253 A

Requires state agencies, departments and political subdivisions to grant to persons who are blind priority to establish and operate vending facilities in public buildings.

Subject to enumerated exceptions, expands definition of "communication in support of or in opposition to a clearly identified candidate or measure" within definition of "independent expenditure" to include aggregate expenses of \$750 or more that refer to candidate or political party within 30 calendar days of primary election or 60 calendar days of general election.
