- SB 129 \*\* \*Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means Establishes Task Force on Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder in Oregon.
- SB 130 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Waives fees for obtaining medical marijuana card for veterans who have total disability rating of at least 50 percent as result of injury or illness incurred or aggravated during active military service, and who received discharge or release under other than dishonorable conditions.
- SB 364 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue then to Tax Credits Creates refundable income tax credit for donating shipping container for storage of emergency supplies in or near public building.
- SB 531 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means Creates Task Force on Rural Fire Protection District Community Development to study and develop recommendations for developing, enhancing or expanding ability of rural fire protection districts to facilitate community development following natural disaster.
- SB 661 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Prohibits sweeping of moneys in Emergency Communications Account, except in case of fiscal emergency.
- SB 707 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes issuance of Article XI-Q bonds to finance seismic and life safety improvements to State Capitol building and grounds.

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to develop and implement one or more programs statewide to establish campus veteran resource centers and campus veteran resource coordinators, or expand and enhance existing centers and coordinators, on campuses of community colleges and public universities to help veterans successfully transition from military service to college life, succeed in college, complete educational goals and transition from college to workforce and community.
