#### **Public Hearing** SB 562 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue

Authorizes county to exempt up to \$250,000 of assessed value of each homestead owned and occupied by surviving spouse of person in active military service killed in line of duty from ad valorem property taxes imposed by all taxing jurisdictions. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue

SB 694 \*\*

Grants higher property tax exemption for property of veterans with disabilities.

SB 832 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs, in collaboration with Office of Rural Health, to establish program to provide grants to qualified nonprofit organizations to provide services to veterans and veterans' families in rural areas of this state.
