Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 81
Directs Director of Veterans' Affairs to provide statewide expertise, advocacy, coordination and assistance to veterans to assist veterans in navigating federal, state and local health care and mental health care systems for purpose of obtaining health care and mental health care.
- SB 380
Requires State Parks and Recreation Commission to allow disabled veterans to make reservations for use of state park areas one month prior to reservation system being made available to general public.
- SB 707 **
Authorizes issuance of Article XI-Q bonds to finance seismic and life safety improvements to State Capitol building and grounds. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 850
Allows State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to require use of risk mitigation methods in, or to prohibit construction of, certain facilities and structures at proposed development site in tsunami inundation zone.
- SB 851
Directs Oregon Military Department to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2018, regarding implementation of Oregon Code of Military Justice.
- SB 852
Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2018, regarding delivery of veterans' services.
- SB 853
Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to conduct statewide study regarding veteran-owned small businesses no later than July 1, 2018.
- SB 1021 **
Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to conduct statewide study regarding veteran-owned small businesses no later than July 1, 2018. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
