Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 7 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Finance and Revenue
Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules applying certain oil spill prevention and emergency response planning requirements to high hazard train routes in this state.
- SB 531 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to General Government and Accountability then to Ways and Means
Creates Task Force on Rural Fire Protection District Community Development to study and develop recommendations for developing, enhancing or expanding ability of rural fire protection districts to facilitate community development following natural disaster.
- SB 707 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Authorizes issuance of Article XI-Q bonds to finance seismic and life safety improvements to State Capitol building and grounds.
- SB 1000
Changes name of "Oregon State Defense Force" to "Oregon Civil Defense Force."
Authorizes Superintendent of State Police to form volunteer Oregon State Police Civil Defense Force to provide emergency response and communications, medical assistance, logistical support and other aid.
