- SB 398  
Requires pay stub summary to include notice of potential availability of earned income tax credit to employee.
- SB 92  
Allows Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to set civil penalties for violations of state occupational health and safety statutes, not to exceed maximum penalties or fall below certain minimum penalties under federal Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970.
- SB 93 \*\*  
Increases from \$250,000 to \$1 million maximum amount credited to Workers' Memorial Scholarship Account from civil penalties recovered for violations of occupational health and safety standards. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 139 \*\*  
Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for construction and capital equipment of innovation and workforce training center in Rockwood neighborhood of Gresham. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 296 \*\*  
Requires Director of Employment Department to study eligibility of employees of educational institutions for unemployment insurance benefits. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
