#### **Oregon Public Employees Retirement System Contingency Reserve Fund**

#### **Public Hearing**

SB 200

Allows member of Public Employees Retirement System to purchase retirement credit for periods of service in uniformed services.

SB 201

Provides that remuneration paid to certain employee of university with governing board who lives and performs service within United States is deemed includable in employee's taxable income during period of employment with university.

SB 214

Provides that post-doctoral scholars at public universities and Oregon Health and Science University are not eligible to participate in Public Employees Retirement System or optional retirement plans offered by universities.

SB 464

Directs Public Employees Retirement Board to reimburse certain recipient of reduced payment under Public Employees Retirement System if recipient establishes that payment was subject to Oregon personal income tax.

SB 486 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Exempts retired members of Public Employees Retirement System from limitations on reemployment if member is reemployed as police officer by public university or Oregon Health Science University.

SB 811

Provides that employees of Oregon State Hospital qualify as police officers under Public Employees Retirement System.
